

Master Class 2018 HRS4R Assessment

Description

Many of the institutions awarded after 2014 have to prepare their interim assessment while those awarded before 2014 will undergo an internal assessment; these institutions need to prepare their external assessment, and new action plan revised according to the strengthened procedure including OTM-R issues.

The training program will be designed for enabling the participants to know precisely about the assessment (conferences), share their practices and questions (workshops) and meet experts (individual meetings).
